



When leaving A1. Standard give way rules apply

- Vehicle A1 can utilise the centre of road area to pause/wait whilst attempting a right turn or straight drive if; (Your vehicle can fit into the space provided) and
 - Give way to B and or H if indicating a right turn and standard give way rule is adhered to (ie) safe gap selection is available
 - No other car is already in centre of road waiting
 - give way to Vehicle D
 - if traveling all the way give way to E and G

Once Vehicle A is in centre of road see 2nd picture of vehicle A2

- If vehicle B and H come along after vehicle A is in centre of road, then vehicle A has right of way.
- Vehicle A must still Give Way to vehicle E and pedestrian G
- Vehicle D now has to give way to vehicle A2
- Standard give way rule still apply
- It remains as always. **“be prepared”** if other vehicles do not obey road law.
